Business Meeting Recap

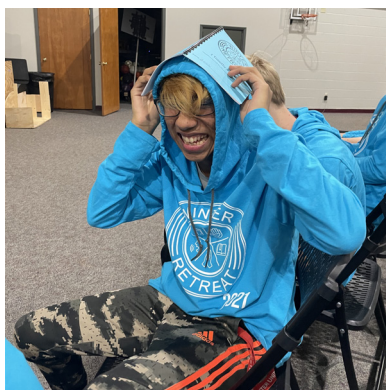
First, we want to thank all of those who participated in the meeting (especially those who joined online via Zoom) for their patience as we tried to remedy the audio issues.

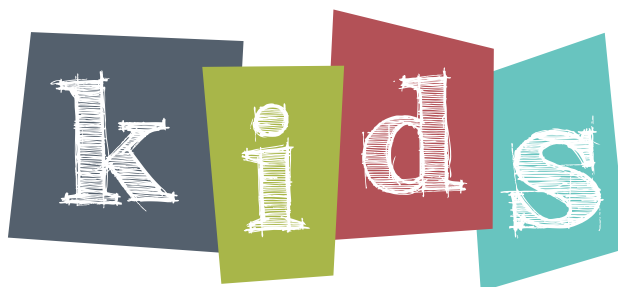
If you remember, last year we held a Men's Ministry Summit in February and it was such a great time! This year will be even better.

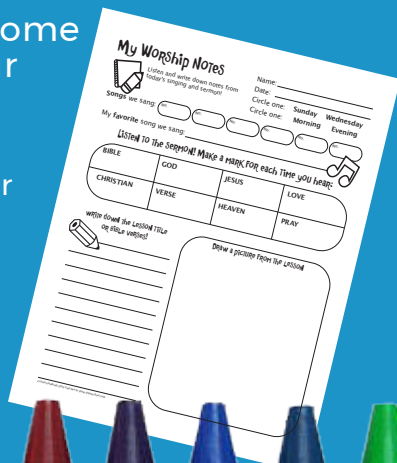

The church here in Pomasqui is doing very well, people are excited to study the Word. Public gatherings are prohibited, so we have all meetings and counseling online. I have not been able to travel to the jungle region lately because even though the government removed strict lockdown, we have travel limitations.
