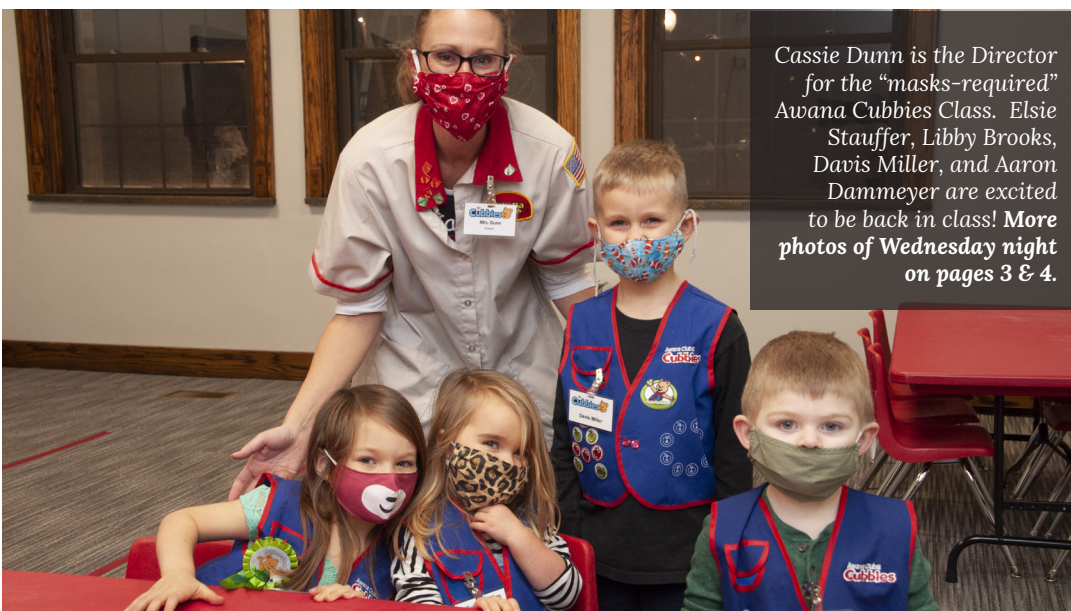

Pray for Myanmar

An update from Headwaters Missionary, Myron Youngman, on the situation in Myanmar:

Sunday night (1/31) here in the states—early Monday (2/1) Myanmar

time—I started to receive messages from ministry friends and partners in Myanmar that a coup d'etat was underway being led by the military.

The Coup d'Etat

The coup began just before the new session of Myanmar's parliament was to open. The Nobel Prize Winner, Aung San Suu Kyi, who has been the State Counsellor of Myanmar (essentially the President since a 2015 election) has been detained along with a number of other members of her party, the National League for Democracy (NLD). This move by the military follows another landslide win by Ms. Suu Kyi's party in the elections this last fall. This was only the second election since the last military led government. The NLD won 396 out of 476 seats. **However, with the coup the top army commander is now in charge, and a one-year state of emergency has been declared.**

A State of Emergency

On Monday phones were down, some banks closed, and all television stations were shut down except for the one controlled by the military. There was a run on markets for supplies, and a strict curfew from 8pm to 6am was initiated.

As of Tuesday evening, around 100 government ministers from the NLD are still being held in military custody. The military has purged the Cabinet of Ministers and Deputy Ministers from the NLD government and replaced them with a new administration either from or with strong ties to the military. The expelled ministers have been told to leave their government housing within three days.

It is Wednesday morning now in Myanmar, and the government hospital staff in several major cities are planning to organize a strike. They have said they will strike and peacefully protest against the coup. There is a call for civil disobedience and similar strikes all across the country.

Our Ministry Partners

Wi-fi has been sporadic, but thus far we have been able to touch base with well over two dozen of our ministry friends and partners in Myanmar. Right now, we at Kaifa are waiting and watching. We are keeping tabs on how this might impact all of our ministry partners in Myanmar; in particular how this might impact the ministry in

Myanmar, including the launch of new ministries. There is much concern and angst right now as the effects of the previous 60 years of military rule are still quite fresh in people's minds.

Please pray:

Ask God to encourage our partners at this time, and to give them the ability to look beyond the circumstances of this week to all of the hurting and anxious people around them,

Ask God to provide our partners with the ability to see "barriers" as vehicles for ministry, and the knowledge to know just what to say and what to do in this time of angst, and

Ask God to preserve the ministries that have been established in Myanmar for the advancement of His Kingdom. ■

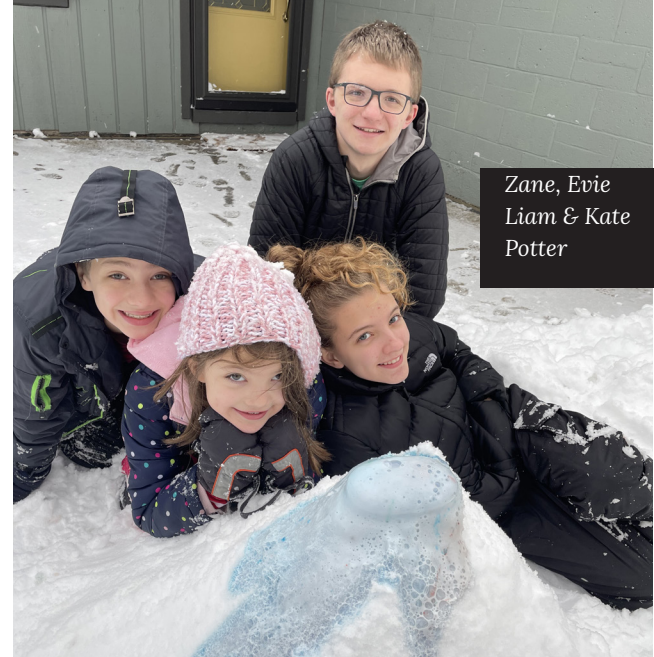

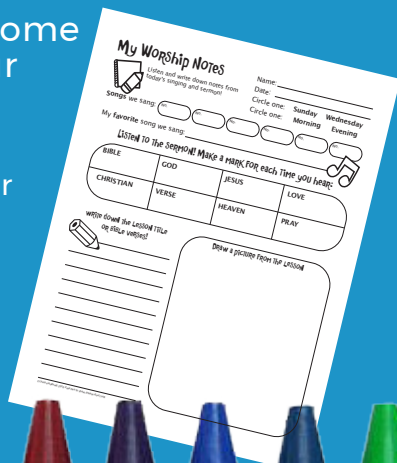
