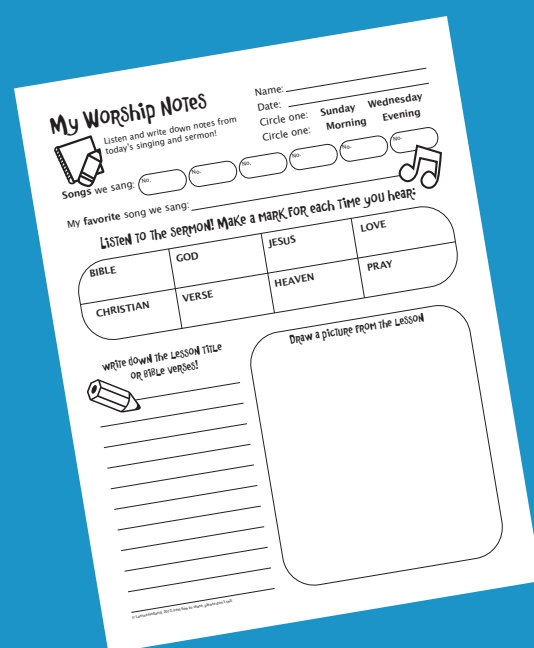


# Join Our next GriefShare Group

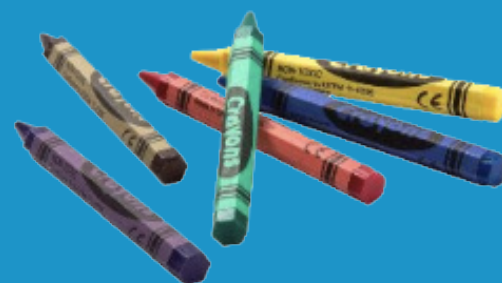
