Ministry Spotlight

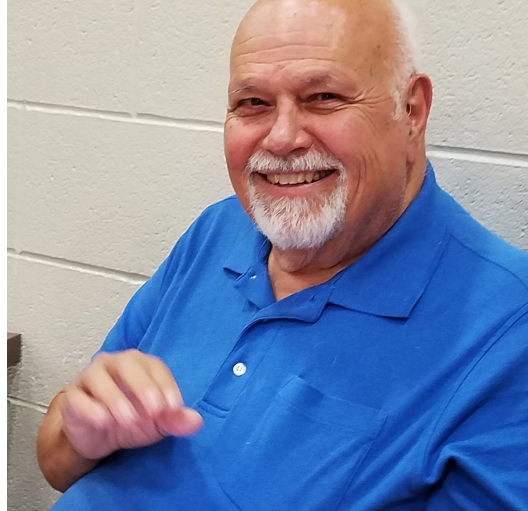
Mondays are Better with Pickleball

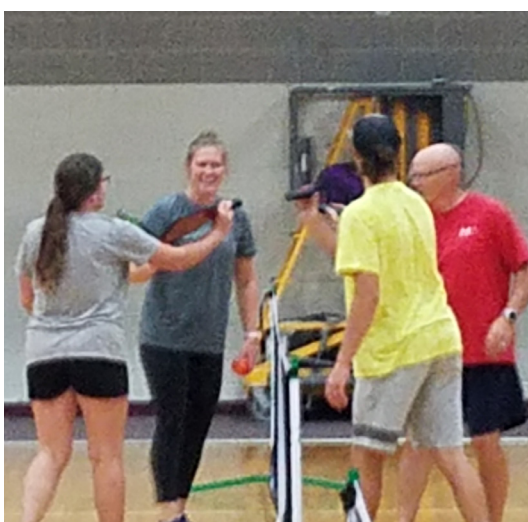

People who get alongside parents and children to befriend, mentor and support, providing companionship and friendship to those who are isolated or suffering.

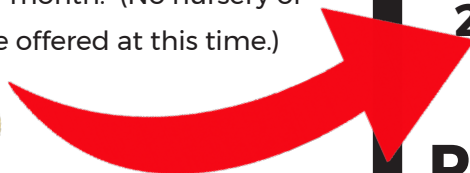
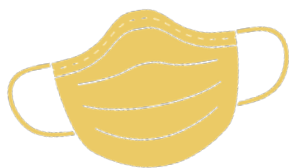
Resource Friend

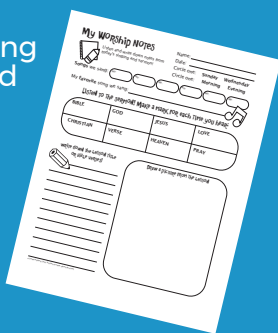
