TRANSFORMED

from one degree of glory to another

Last Sunday I mentioned that our New Year's Emphasis will focus on the transfiguration. If you're newer, this is when we pause our regular study and, as a whole church, center on the same topic to begin the year. The transfiguration is intuitively significant, yet for various reasons hasn't been deeply considered in many American Evangelical circles.

I tend to love the black sheep of Scripture—passages that don't get much attention but often yield surprising value. That has certainly been true as I've studied the transfiguration. The understanding of Christ, the life of His followers, and the implications for the church seem almost endless in this brief story. I expect it to be a rich study.

A quick note on our approach. The sermons will focus on the figures present at the transfiguration—Moses, Elijah, Peter, James, John, and then the Church (that will make sense in the final sermon), while the ABFs, Youth, and children's classes will study the transfiguration story itself. These are designed to work together. You won't get the full picture unless you're involved both hours. The new year is a great time to jump in.

Two potential objections:

First, "I'm not into theology." Everyone is a theologian in the sense that we all have a view of God that shapes our lives. You may not enjoy academic theology, but I hope you're eager to know Jesus more fully.

Second, "Is this applicable?" The series is titled Transformed. We'll end in II Corinthians 3, where Paul draws from the transfiguration to show that as we behold Christ, we are transformed "from one degree of glory to another." Nothing is more applicable to the Christian life than seeing Jesus rightly.

I pray this study is of great value to each person at Headwaters. Let us behold Christ together and delight in the transformation that follows.

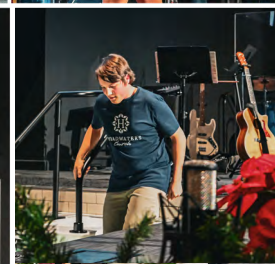
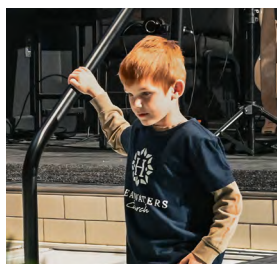
Christmas Music Fest
