WEATHER POLICY

Just in case you missed it, we have stumbled upon winter in full force. If you're new to winter, a few things... gloves are to keep your hands from getting cold, not to warm them up after they are cold; don't pour hot water on your windshield to get rid of the ice; and we try not to cancel Sunday morning church if possible.

You may ask, "Didn't we cancel church last Sunday?" Why yes, we did. Thank you for noticing, and I would like to explain that and help inform how we make those decisions so you can understand in the future. On Sunday mornings, our standard position has been to have church unless there is a weather emergency that rises to the level of a "warning" according to the [Indiana Department of Transportation](#). When this happens, legal driving is limited to emergency management workers. Apart from these instances, we will have church. We may cancel first service but will likely have second service and allow each person/family to decide if they are able to travel safely.

Last Sunday, that was our plan. We canceled first service to give more time for snow management and had a great team of folks helping clear our parking lots. However, as our parking lots were cleared, they were simultaneously icing over. It was quickly evident that even those who could get to church safely would have to navigate an unsafe parking lot, and so we decided to cancel. Our policy is still to have church unless we are legally prohibited from driving, but when our facilities are not safe, we may be forced to cancel.

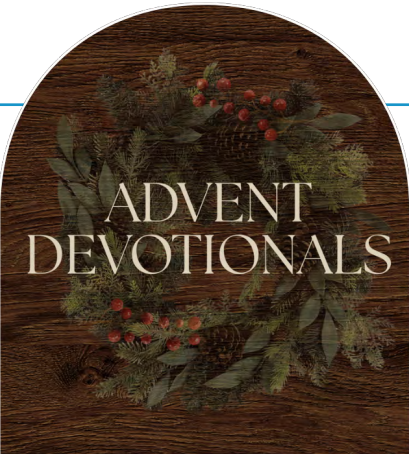

 WED, DEC 24  5:30PM  SANCTUARY

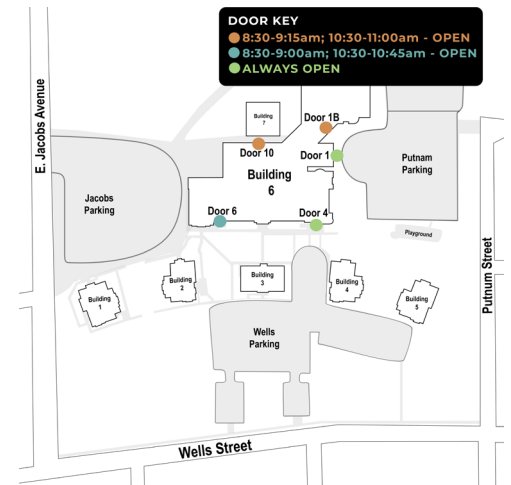
