Noah's HOPE

Headwaters Women

Together to Help & Heal

Largest Turnout Ever

We were overwhelmed with gratitude to see so many women at Noah's Hope Sunday night!!! Forty-four women gathered to assemble bears for families leaving the hospital with empty arms after the loss of a baby, including 15 women from our community.

In 2007 Kristin Koning and friends at Headwaters Church (then Wallen) launched Noah's Hope to remember Kristin's son Noah and give something to the hospitals to help other mom's through loss.

Never could we have imagined that all these years later the gathering to assemble bears would become a ministry in and of itself—a place of healing and connection for women in our church and community.

What an honor to hear so many stories of precious babies dearly loved and gone too soon. We honored their legacies in our work Sunday night.

We boxed **140 "Noah Bears"** for mommas experiencing loss of an infant in the Labor & Delivery unit or NICU, **110 "Small Bears"** for early loss and miscarriage, and **300 "Baby Bears"** for siblings of babies who don't get to come home. These bears will be delivered to PRMC, Randallia, Whitley, DeKalb, Lutherand & Dupont hospitals, in both the L&D and NIC units.

We **prayed** for the families who will be receiving these bears and for the hospital staff and volunteers who offer support. May they know how deeply they are loved and find HOPE in their darkest hour.

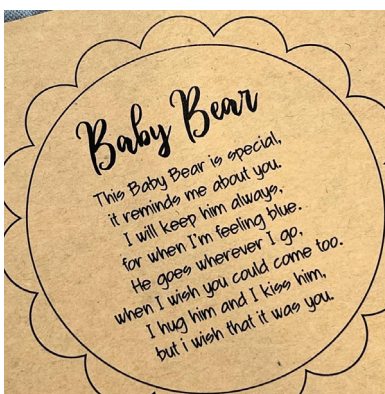

NEW KIDS CHECK-IN SYSTEM

YOUR CHILD'S SAFETY IS A TOP PRIORITY. This new system will increase security in the drop off/ pick up process. It will allow you to check your child in and print a sticker yourself before bringing them to class. You can still use your **Parent ID Card** through the month of February, but we encourage you to try the new system the next time you're at church. **After March 6th your Parent ID Card will no longer be accepted in picking up your child.**



2 WAYS TO CHECK-IN:

CHURCH CENTER APP

- Open ChurchCenter App on your phone
- Go to CHECK-IN (bottom right)
- Select child you want to check in to get a QR Code
- Be sure to check all services they will be in class
- Find a Self-Serve Kiosk
- Scan your QR Code. Stickers will print automatically
- Put **Name Tag Stickers** on your child's shirt
- Keep **Pick-up Sticker**
- Take child to class
