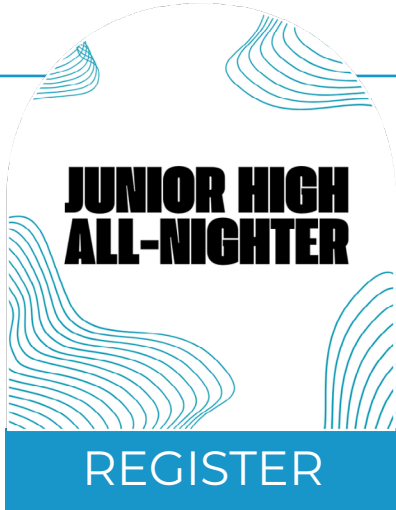
What: Moms with littles—time to get out of the house and enjoy some fun together! Join us for a relaxed morning of play and connection. (For kids ages 5 and under, please.)

PARTNER WITH US TO BUILD A PLAYGROUND

After working with several companies to gather ideas, designs, and quotes for a playground at Headwaters Church, we have developed a plan to move forward. This playground is intended to serve our church congregation, Classical Roots Christian School, and the local community.

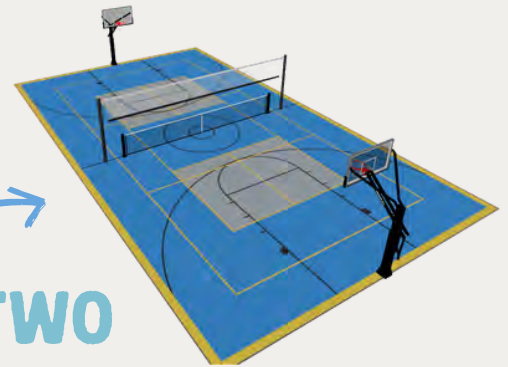
The project is divided into three phases. **Phase One** includes playground equipment, picnic tables, and upgraded mulch. **Phase Two** adds a multi-use sports court for basketball, four square, volleyball, and other games, along with a fence surrounding the entire area. **Phase Three** includes an outdoor amphitheater built into the hillside, providing a space for teaching and general gatherings, while also serving as a pathway from the upper level down to the playground.

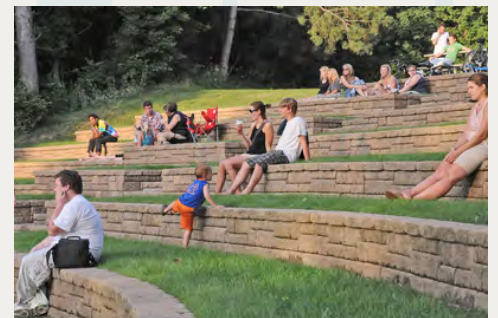
PLAYGROUND & PICNIC TABLES
