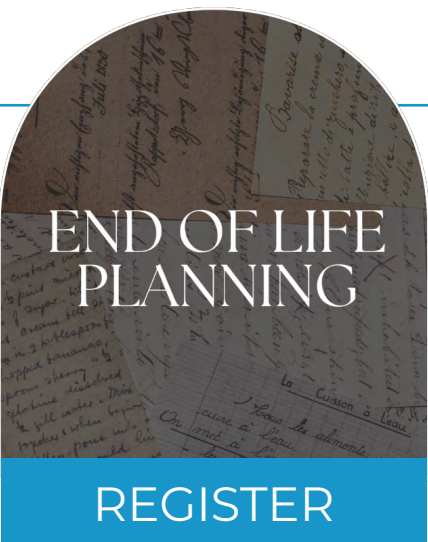

END OF LIFE PLANNING CLASS

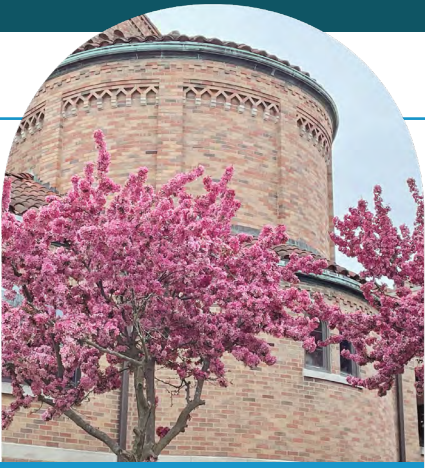
 THURS, APR 9 - MAY 7  6-7:30PM

SPECIAL GIVING OPPORTUNITY

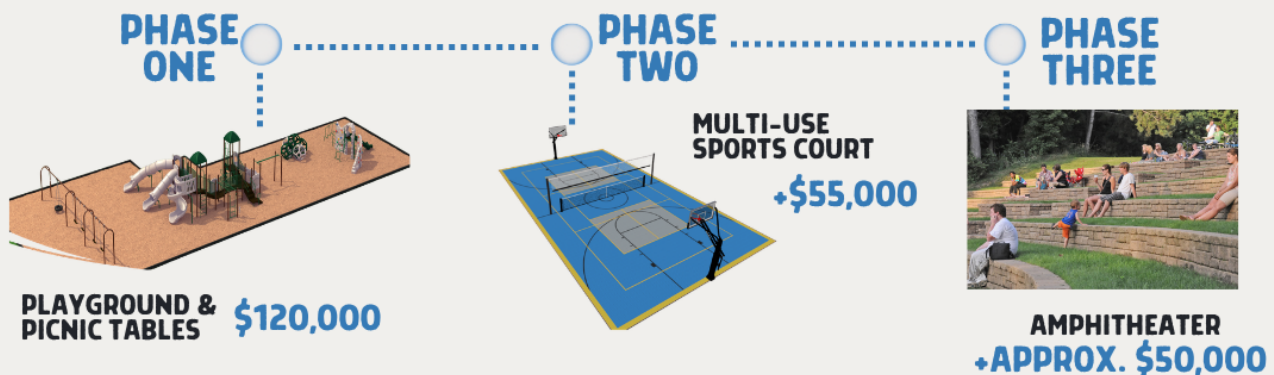
PLAYGROUND UPGRADE
