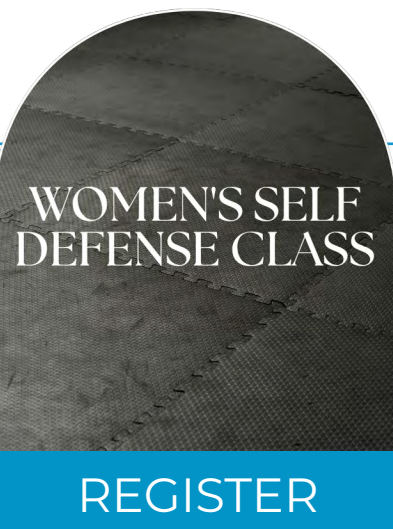

Parents,

Headwaters Youth Group has made it our goal to provide an opportunity for a cross-cultural missions trip. We believe that these opportunities give your student a new understanding of the world, serving others, breaking through comfort zones, and how God loves all people. We have been partnering with a few missionaries in Ecuador for this trip in years past but have found that we are very limited in how many students we can bring. Since our youth group continues to grow and we still feel the conviction to provide this experience for as many as we can we are going to be introducing a second trip, to Guatemala, for you to consider. The two trips will look different in mission while in the field but will accomplish the same mission stated above. The Ecuador trip will be a youth group trip completely composed of Headwaters Youth students and leaders while the Guatemala trip can be more of a family-oriented trip, with parents and younger siblings able to attend as well.

We will be presenting the details of both trips at a parent meeting on May 16th. Attendance to the parent meeting is REQUIRED in order to register for the Ecuador trip. This meeting is on Saturday the 16th from 3-5pm in the Sr. High Youth Room. Attending this meeting does not guarantee your ability to go on the trip to Ecuador but it does qualify you to register at a later date.

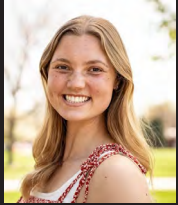
