


# **UPCOMING EVENTS**

# **MISSIONS MOMENT**

Please pray for the Pfennigers, a Headwaters family who have a goal of moving to Togo West Africa in the summer of 2024. Drs. Fred and Lydia are Family Medicine and OB Fellowship trained physicians. Fred also has ER Fellowship training. They have four children Noah (11), Nathanael (8), Noemi (5) and Noll (3). They have completed two previous terms to Hospital Baptist Biblique (HBB) in Togo West Africa - a 30-month term with Samaritans Purse post residency program (Jan 2013 to July 2015) and a 24-month term with ABWE (August 2016 to June 2018).

In the fall of 2021, the Pfennigers made the decision to return to HBB as full-time missionaries with ABWE. Christ teaches not only the importance of love and compassion in time of need, but the importance of relationships. They are going back to be a part of the lives of the Togolese, who come to HBB.

HBB has previously provided OB care that included 600 deliveries a year. However, due to a lack of OB providers, HBB had to close the OB program. The Pfennigers have been asked to reopen the OB service when they return to the field. Their goal is not simply to re-open OB, but to create an in-house midwife training program that will be part of a long-term solution. Their desire is that the OB care provided would be God-centered and bring glory to God's name
