Helping Ukrainian Refugees

The students donated both their time and registration money to a ministry called Project-216. This is a not for profit in just down the road from Headwaters that packs boxes to end world hunger. We packed over 5,000 meals to ship to Ukraine and Ukrainian refugees.

As you can see the week was jam packed with hard work and ministry but we also had loads of fun including a photo scavenger hunt, an evening at Promenade Park, a day at the Lake, and "Story Time with Craig [Smith]."

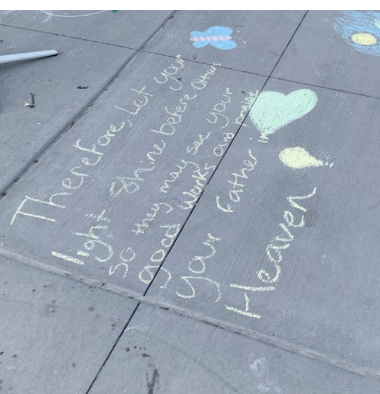
The Lesson: GO

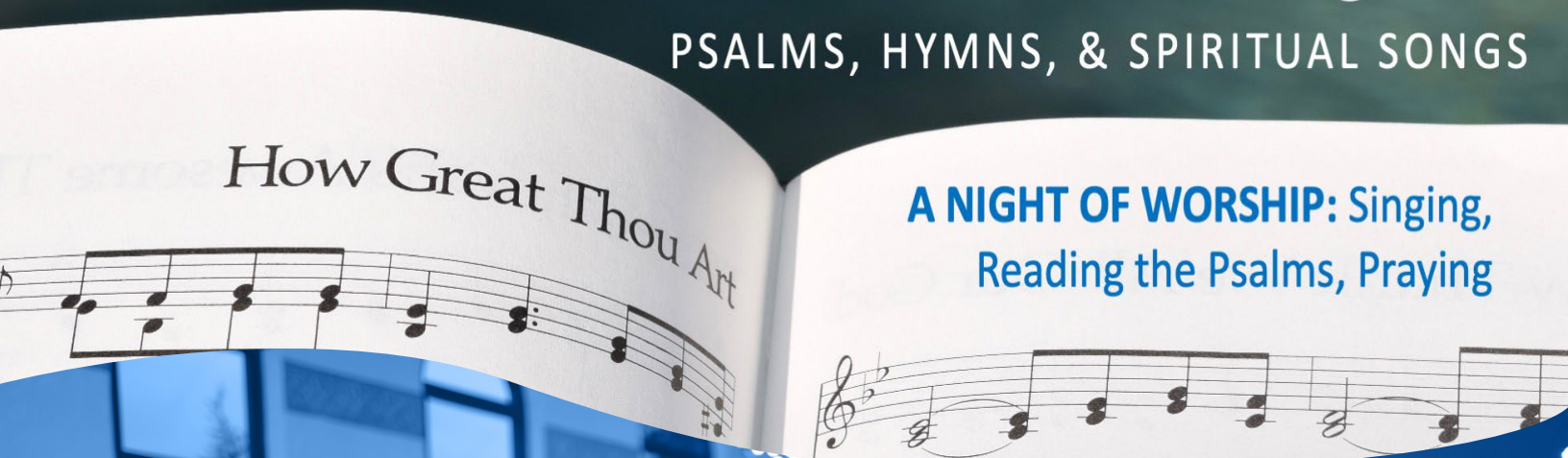

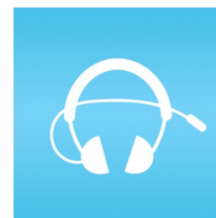
