 AUG 23  12:30PM

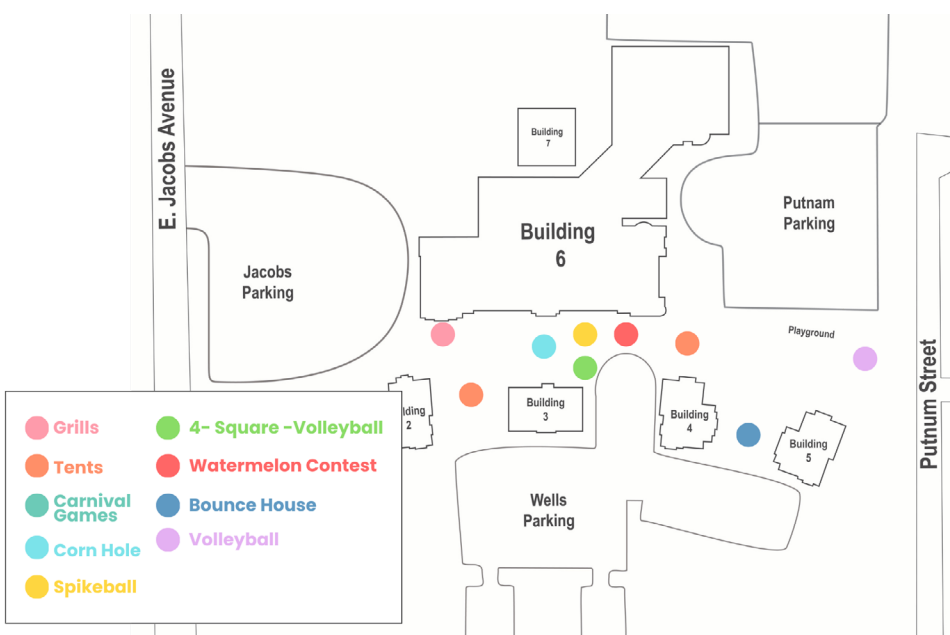
Join us for our annual Church Picnic—an afternoon of fun, food, and fellowship! The picnic will begin at 12:30pm following second service.

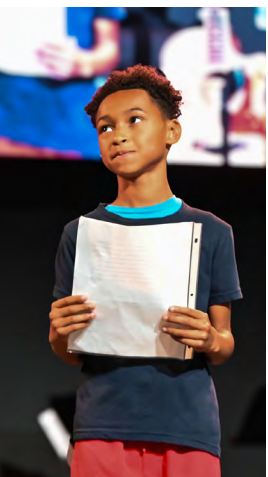
YOUNG ADULTS WORSHIP NIGHT

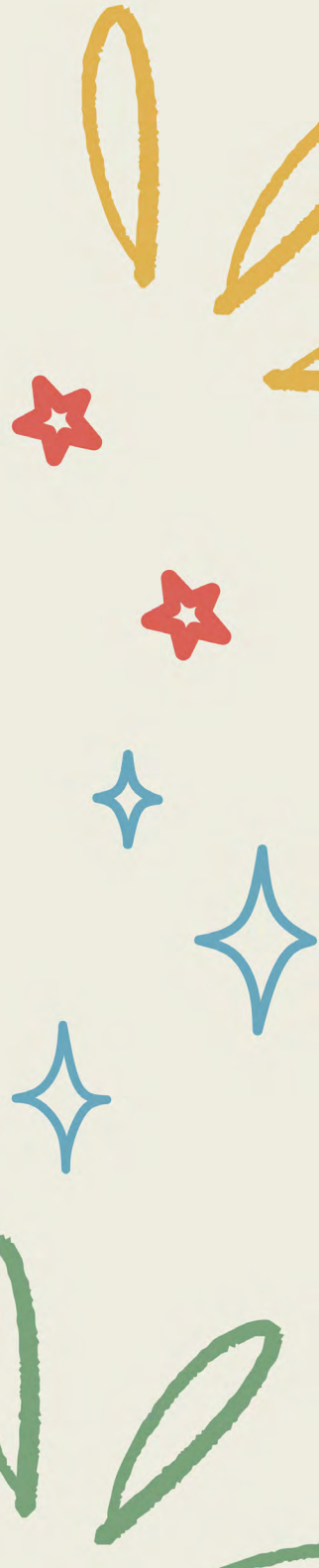
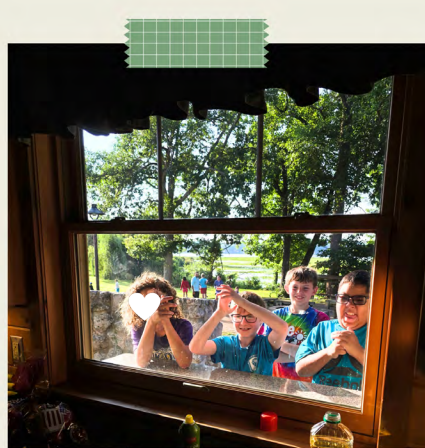
BAPTISMS
