Registration includes the required participation waiver. You may also register and pay at the door.

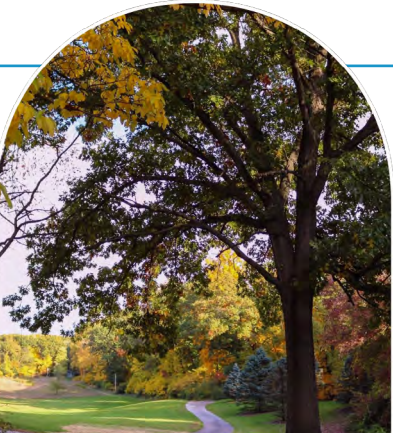

CHURCH PICNIC

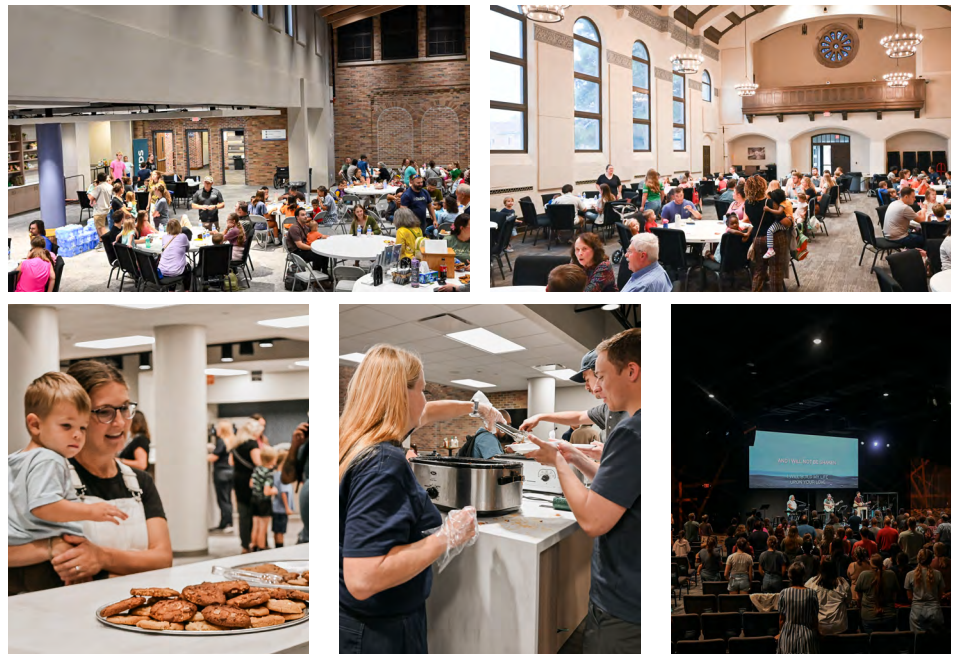
