



ABIDE: A STUDY OF 1,2, & 3 JOHN [WOMEN'S STUDY]

Teacher: Christine Overholt

Description: Let what you heard from the beginning abide in you (1 John 2:24)... How can we hold onto assurance of our faith? How can we discern the truth from a lie? How can we know God loves us? In these three short letters, the apostle John reminds an early church facing division, deception, and doubt to hold fast to what they know and to live like they believe it. SOUL CARE & DISCIPLESHIP FUNDAMENTALS CLASS

Teacher: Scott Meinema

Description: This Fundamentals course serves as an introductory exploration of Biblical Soul Care, encompassing both its theological foundations and practical applications. The course consists of 35 online lectures, specifically designed to provide participants with an overview of how the scriptures provide both hope and help with the issues of life. To ensure an engaging learning experience, the course is structured in a way that allows each participant to listen to three lectures per week at their own pace. Following this, participants are expected to attend the weekly class session, which offers an opportunity for interaction and discussion centered around the lecture content. Each participant is provided with a 100+ page notebook, weekly access to online lectures, and opportunities in class to interact with the content, ask questions, and dig deeper into what they are learning. Scheduled every Wednesday from 6:30-8pm, the course commences on August 23.

RESOURCE ROOM


Our Resource Room is a great space for all kinds of teaching needs. We want them to be used! Please make sure you return items that are used for various projects and lessons.

- 4. Please be prompt in retrieving kids after Sunday services. We want to respect our teachers' time.



SEPT 7 | NEXT JUBILEE LADIES EVENT


