- New Testament qualifications for Deacons drawn from 1 Timothy 3:8-12.

- Has integrity/credibility.
- Is not under the influence of alcohol or other controlling substances.
- Is not greedy or dishonest with money.
- Is committed to the faith, behaving as holding true to the gospel.
- Is examined and found blameless in overall character.
- If married, wife is of similarly godly, faithful character.
- Is a one-woman man.
- If married and/or has children, is spiritual leader of family.
